Intervention and Extended Learning Time Strategies

	Intereventions	Extended Time
Bel Air Elementary	Three full-time instructional aides. Full-time reading interventionist, no math interventionist.	Summer school through district, no school based after-school program
Chadwick Elementary	Complex system of intervetions with most happening in the classroom through small group instruction. Have a reading and math interventionist	Homework help two days a week for one hour
Chillum Elementary	1.0 Math Resource teacher and .2 reading and math RTI staff. Also leverage a number of volunteers for one-on-one interventions	Have a four hour per week after school program. Do not currently have summer school.
Fairmont Heights High School	Most interventions within courses	Participate in the Hillside Work Scholarship Program. Provides tutoring and other supports. Not all students can access due to wait list
Harrison Elementary	Two days a week of district supported interventionist.	No summer school and after school targeted to LEP students

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North Frederick Elementary	3.0 Interention Teachers working k-5 in small group and one-on-one.	Extended Learning Opportunity is 3 days a week for one hour. Use 10 11 month contracts to pay for this.
North Hagerstown High School	2.0 instructional interventionists for math and English - pullout support for English	National honors society students provide peer tutoring in every subject. APEX for students to make up failed portion of classes - 4 days a week
Parkland Magnet Middle	2.8 instructional interventionists - alternative programs, reading specialists, academic interventions	Math Detention on Fridays - English and math extended learning after-school 2 days a week for 3 months- Has the largest summer school program in the district
Patterson Park Public Charter	2.6 title 1 teachers - reading interventionist pushes into k-1 - ABC parents group pulls students out of classroom - push out and pull in for at risk students depending on teachers' needs	School added prekindergarten to build a solid foundation - After school program PASS for elementary students - CREATE for Middle Schoool - there is PPPCS summer school

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Redland Middle School	0.6 interventionist - 1.0 Math focus teacher - works with students to focus on Algebra of 17 kids that are struggling with foundations -	Extended learning Oct - March w. 1hours of instruction in math and English - After-school tutoring for help with school work for 2 hours - Saturday school 2.5 hours from Sept - may - summer school for a fee
Somerset Intermediate	2.0 Interventionist one for English and one for math - struggling students take extra curriculars as support in math and english w. about 6 kids per class -	Summer school - no after school tutoring but can talk to a teacher at lunch
Bates Middle School	2 days a week the school shortens period by 5 min to create a 40 min period to provide intervention support for struggling students -	After-school help 2 days a week . There is also a district run summer school program for students to attend.
