

## Top 10 Administrative Alcohol Violations

- Sale/service of alcohol to patrons under 21.
- Sale/service to intoxicated patrons. Must be observed to posses and or consume alcohol.
- After hours. No alcoholic beverages may be served, dipensed, consumed, furnished, given away on any part of the licensees establishment during the hours posted on license.
- Open container. A licensee, his or her agent(s) and/or employee(s) must not permit any person(s) to leave the licensed premise with an alcoholic beverage in an open container.
- Alcohol awareness training. A certified person must be on the licensed premise during hours in which alcohol is sold.
- 6. Disorderly house. A licensee, his/her agent(s) and/or employee(s) must not permit any person(s) on the licensed premises to: (a) be intoxicated and endanger the safety of another person or property, or (b) be intoxicated or drink any alcoholic beverage and cause a public disturbance.
- No food availability. Food must be available at all times while alcohol is being served.
- 8. Licenses. Must be in a frame and under glass placed in a visible area in public view.
- Unapproved source and storage. No establishment shall sell, store, or keep any alcoholic beverages on the licensed premises except those purchased from DLC.
- Beer, wine, and liquor invoices and employee records.
   Must be available for inspections.
