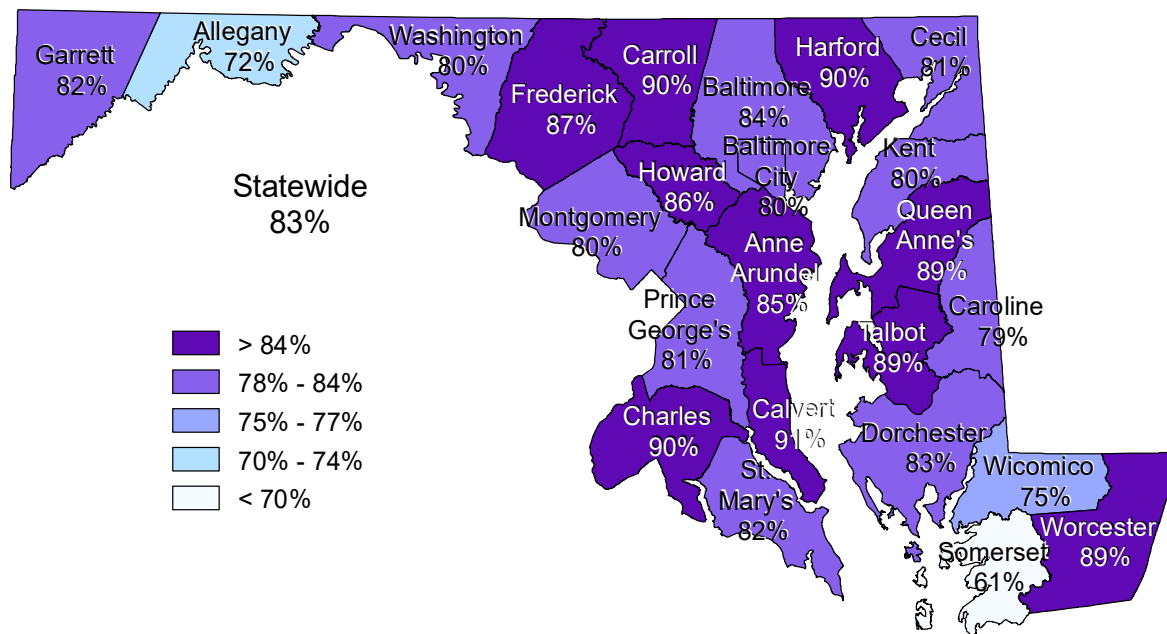
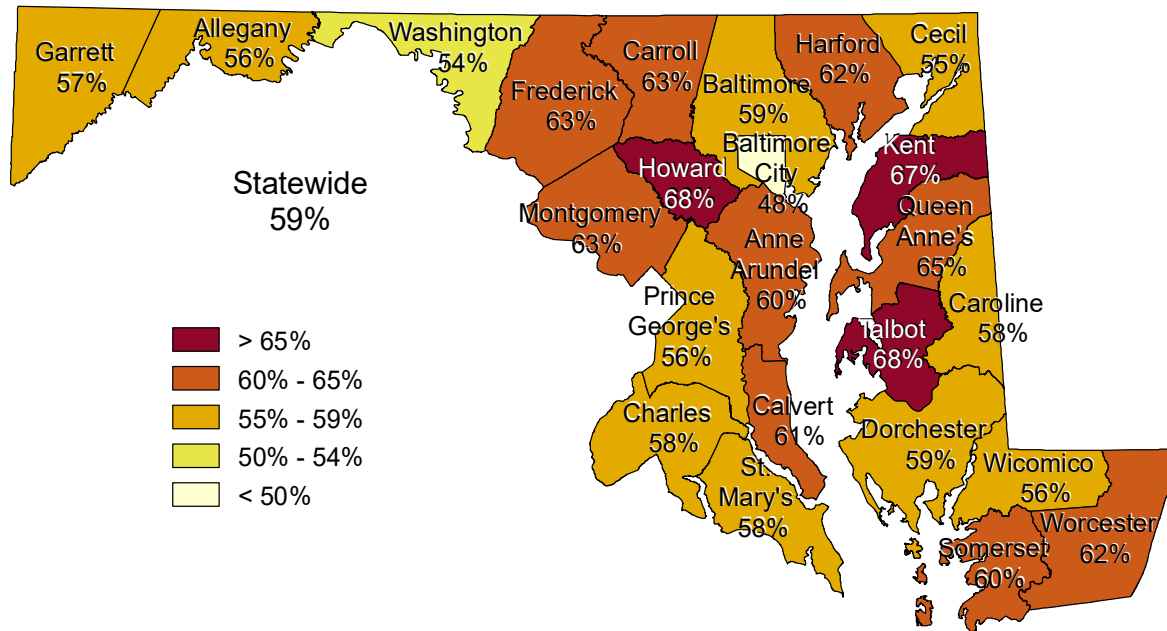


Voter Registration

Note: Voter registration age (16 and over) population includes persons who are not eligible to register to vote, most notably noncitizens and persons in prison for a felony. Some jurisdictions' voter registration percentage may be more affected than others by persons who are ineligible. Somerset County, for example, contains State prison facilities with a significant population relative to the county's overall voter registration age population, and, of all the counties, Montgomery and Prince George's counties' populations have the highest percentages of noncitizens.
