

Primary Election Voter Turnout (as a % of Eligible Registered Voters) – By County 2020, 2022, 2024

- Statewide, the percentage of eligible registered voters who voted in the 2020, 2022, and 2024 primary elections was 42%, 27%, and 28%, respectively. In a primary election, not all registered voters are eligible to vote. Only Democratic Party and Republican Party registered voters, and third party or unaffiliated registered voters who live in a jurisdiction in which a nonpartisan (*i.e.*, school board) race is being voted on, are eligible.
- Among the counties, the percentage of eligible registered voters who voted in the 2020, 2022, and 2024 primary elections ranged from 34% to 48% in 2020, from 21% to 41% in 2022, and from 22% to 36% in 2024.
