

Office of Apprenticeship (OA) Recognized State Apprenticeship Agencies (SAA)



OA vs. SAA: Occupations and Programs

- SAAs offer reciprocity for apprentices, apprenticeship programs, and standards from other SAAs and USDOL OA.
- All OA occupations are approvable in Maryland if they meet licensure and regulatory requirements.
- SAAs may approve additional occupations beyond what OA approves, as long as they conform to 29 CFR 29.

Registered Apprenticeship Occupations



- Funded opportunities for priority populations and emerging industries
