These funds shall be administered in accordance with § 5-313 of the Education Article and can be used for grants to local boards of education for federal E-rate-eligible special construction such as fiber and broadband infrastructure projects for E-rate-eligible applicants, provided that notwithstanding Title 5, Subtitle 3 of the Education Article, a grant awarded by the Interagency Commission on School Construction to a county with the highest student enrollment count in the 2025-2026 school year shall not require a local cost-share match (Regional)
